Balboa Park Botanical Building & Central Gardens

📍 Location

Balboa Park Botanical Building, San Diego, CA

Begin the morning at one of San Diego's most iconic horticultural destinations. The Botanical Building and surrounding gardens showcase a diverse collection of tropical plants, seasonal displays, and beautifully maintained landscapes within the historic setting of Balboa Park. The Botanical Building in Balboa Park, is a historic 1915 landmark, quite recently it has had a massive structural revitalization. Because decades of weather took a toll on the structure, crews completely reconstructed its open-air redwood shell and steel framing. Nan Sterman served as the lead plant and interior garden designer for the Balboa Park Botanical Building renovation. Her involvement included creating the comprehensive plant list, designing the layout for the indoor plant beds, and curating an "otherworldly" selection of plants. What a treat to be led through the park today by Nan.

Her work is highly detailed, with many layers of words, imagery, and texture.

Bobbi Hirschkoff Garden Lunch & Ceramic Art Studio

Enjoy a catered picnic box lunch surrounded by a peaceful garden setting. Bobbi Hirschkoff is a highly versatile, multi-disciplinary artist, and her two-acre garden functions as a dynamic, open-air gallery for her creations. Her artwork is heavily inspired by the natural world, infused with brilliant colors, light, and organic textures.

Angela Noble Garden

Visit a beautiful private garden in one of San Diego's historic neighborhoods, showcasing regional planting styles and personalized design elements.

Angela Noble is heavily involved with the **APLD San Diego District**, where she plays a key role on their Communications Committee (managing email broadcasts and digital outreach) and actively participates in their regional and statewide programs. Her alignment with the APLD perfectly matches her focus on sustainable, design-forward landscaping. It bridges her professional background running her digital agency, with her deeply rooted dedication to ecological landcare and local habitat creation.



Scott & Jim's Garden

Experience a garden reflecting the architectural and horticultural character of a hillside garden. Passersby viewing Jim Bishop and Scott Borden's 1938 Spanish-Revival home from the street would never guess that a horticultural wonderland lies just beyond the front gate. The property covers nearly an acre, but the catch is its topography: the backyard drops a dizzying 100 feet straight down into a north-facing canyon. When the couple bought the estate, this sheer cliff was an impenetrable wilderness of overgrown eucalyptus, dense brush, and old construction debris. Today, it is a terraced, multi-level botanical masterpiece.

Old Town San Diego State Historic Park

This evening, enjoy a walking tour through San Diego's historic Old Town, followed by free time for independent dinner exploration. Known as the "birthplace of California," Old Town San Diego is a vibrant, pedestrian-friendly neighborhood that preserves the region's transition from a Kumeyaay settlement to a Spanish presidio, a Mexican pueblo, and eventually an American frontier town. Visited by millions annually, it offers a distinct mix of living history, open-air museums, bustling artisan marketplaces, and celebrated Mexican dining.



Patrick & Ron's Garden

Visit a welcoming private garden showcasing the owners' personal horticultural interests and landscape style. Located on a sunny, sloping half-acre hillside (in northern San Diego County), the home of Patrick Anderson is widely considered a legendary, world-class residential succulent garden.

Mountain Meadow Mushroom Farms

Next stop, we visit a fascinating, behind-the-scenes mushroom farm. Located in Escondido, this family-owned, organic farm offers guided tours where you can discover the science of mushroom cultivation, from composting to harvest, and take home fresh fungi!



Sage Hill Ranch Gardens Tour & Farewell Picnic

Perched in the backcountry hills of **Escondido, California**, Sage Hill Ranch Gardens is a premier boutique market farm dedicated to ecological food production. Orchestrated by head farmer Spencer, this half-acre property serves as a vibrant blueprint for how intensive, small-footprint agriculture can thrive while actively restoring the surrounding environment. Spencer rejects industrial farming norms in favor of natural systems. Our visit here today includes a tour and our final shared luncheon.

Wanda & Gary's Garden

On the return to Del Mar, enjoy a final private garden visit featuring mature landscapes and a personal approach to gardening. Cultivated from scratch over more than 25 years, this botanical sanctuary is a regular highlight on prestigious regional tours, including those hosted by the Cactus & Succulent Society of America (CSSA) and the San Diego Horticultural Society. The property represents a perfect division of labor: Wanda acts as the visionary head curator with an insatiable appetite for unique flora, while Gary acts as the master builder, fabricator, and daily caretaker who brings those design ideas to life.

Reservations and Payments – A non-refundable deposit of \$ 1000 per person is required at the time of booking. Written confirmation will be provided upon receipt of deposit. Balance of payment will be due 90 days before departure.

Number of Guests - A maximum of 20 guests per tour can be accommodated. A minimum of 16 guests are required to operate the tour at the quoted price. The purchase of non-refundable services outside of tour itinerary (such as airline tickets) before a minimum number of guests have registered is at the sole risk and expense of the guest. We will advise when to proceed to book your air.

Cancellations – All cancellations must be made in writing. As noted, final payment is due 90 days prior to departure and is non-refundable. We strongly recommend that you purchase appropriate cancellation insurance. Hotel – Hotel shown on your itinerary. Sterling Tours reserves the right to change any hotel through any circumstance---the substitute will be of equal or higher quality.
