

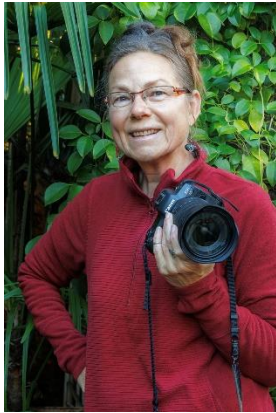

Meet your host, acclaimed garden photographer Doreen Wynja for our Portland and beyond tour!



For over three decades, Doreen has been capturing the soul of plants and private sanctuaries through her camera lens. As the principal photographer for Monrovia Nursery since 2004, her iconic imagery has shaped the visual world of modern horticulture. Her work is regularly featured in top publications – including *Garden Design*, *Fine Gardening*, and *Landscape Architecture* – as well as celebrated books like *The Tapestry Garden* and her recent title, *The Spirited Garden: Creative Private Retreats* (guests on the tour will receive a copy). Doreen brings a deeply intimate knowledge of Pacific Northwest plants, microclimates, and design. Whether she's pointing out surprising foliage pairings, sharing stories from her time shooting behind the scenes with Monrovia's growers, or helping you see private gardens in a whole new light, touring with Doreen promises a uniquely inspiring perspective on Portland's top private and public gems.

Depart by coach for a full day of private garden discoveries across the Portland metropolitan area. Visit a series of stunning private residential gardens in SW Portland and West Linn, showcasing unique regional plant collections and creative landscape design. Continue to a local Farm for our private tour, special planned event and luncheon, including fizz and wine.



Conclude the day at Little Prince Nursery for an insider's look at specialized plant cultivation before returning to the hotel. Afterward, enjoy open free time to stroll, shop, and dine along vibrant N Mississippi Avenue.



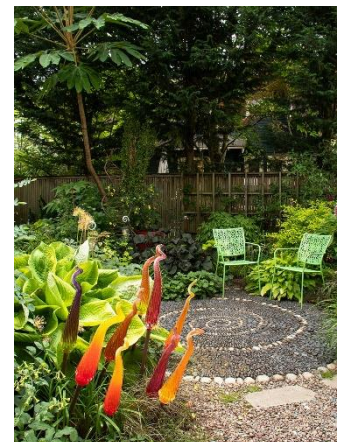

Friday, June 18: Willamette Valley Estates, Olive Oils & REMY Wines

This information is important, please read it carefully. Submission of an online or printed Booking Form along with payment of required trip deposit indicates you have read and expressly agree to these Terms and Conditions. If there is something that you do not understand please ask us about it!

Reservations and Payments – A non-refundable deposit of \$800.00 per person is required at the time of booking. Written confirmation will be provided upon receipt of the deposit. Balance of payment will be due 90 days before departure.

Number of Guests - A maximum of 20 guests per tour can be accommodated. A minimum of 16 guests is required to operate the tour at the quoted price. *The purchase of non-refundable services outside of tour itinerary (such as airline tickets) before a minimum number of guests have registered is at the sole risk and expense of the guest. Please wait for Sterling to confirm minimum number of guests before purchasing your air.*

Cancellations – All cancellations must be made in writing. As noted, final payment is due 90 days prior to departure and is non-refundable. We strongly recommend that you purchase appropriate cancellation insurance.

Hotel – Hotel shown on your itinerary. Sterling Tours reserves the right to change any hotel through any circumstance---the substitute will be of equal or higher quality.

Scheduled Activities – Every effort will be made to provide such services as listed, but where unavoidable circumstances necessitate changes, the best substitute alternatives will be made at the discretion of Sterling Tours, the local escort, or the ground operator without financial compensation to tour members.

Some of the places we will be visiting can only be seen on foot with no other access possible. Guests with limited mobility MUST consult with Sterling prior to tour registration.
